Youneverknowwhatyouwillhave available,sopiecesshouldbeselfcontained.(Bringyourownpropsandstuff).Sometimeswemightevenbe outsideinthecourtyard.Performers won'thavemuchmoreanideawhattoexpectthantheaudience.Asforrules, youcan'tbreakanylawsorendanger yourself,yourperformers,oryouraudie ence.Otherthanthatitsmostlygood senseandfirecodes.Seatingislimited soyouhavetopaytowatch.\$5atthe door. \$99.99foraOneYearPass.
